








Has the school provided the necessary equipment (Chromebook, iPad, laptop) for your student to participate in online classes/distance learning in a language the student is fluent in?


Do you know if your student is turning his/her schoolwork on time?





Which from the following areas is your number one concern? Select four in order of importance.










If your child is an English Learner, is he/she receiving the support needed?
